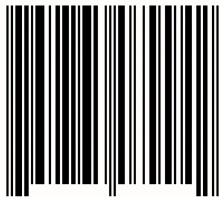

This early Christ For The Nations Worship recording features Mike Massa and Dutch Sheets leading worship, capturing the deeply spontaneous dynamic that defined CFNI in its formative years. From unrehearsed songs to prophetic utterances and singing in the spirit, to the active, demonstrative participation of the congregation, every moment reflects a worship culture that was quite raw and unpretentious.

There were no overdubs, no click tracks, and no carefully constructed arrangements. To some, it may feel primitive or even naive. But for those involved, the purpose was simple: the exaltation of, and interaction with, the living God.

This is the sound of late 1970s and 1980s praise and worship as it emerged from charismatic centers like Christ For The Nations Institute, birthing a movement that would go on to shape congregational worship around the world. These earliest recordings were not commercial products. Many had no cover art, track listings, or formal credits. They were copied and shared from person to person, traveling from church to church, spreading organically without marketing or name recognition.

The goal was never performance, but presence; to capture the sound of praise and worship in its most sincere form, and to offer it as a model for those hungry for a deeper, more authentic connection with God.
